Please Consider the following:

You may notice that on the grading policy as described above, no category for homework has being assigned. This means that <u>we do not need to report a grade for HW, but we may assign it, if needed.</u> If we assign HW, this one will be checked by the teacher and students will get the corresponding feedback but it will not be recorded or reported as no weight or percentage is assigned to HW.

For subjects such as Math, LA, and Idioma Español, we may assign differentiated HW when needed. This means that HW will be assigned, only if students need to have extra practice at home in order to reach the class objectives. If assigned it must be:

- ✓ Meaningful to the student
- √ The task must be one that the student may carry it out on its own.(no supervision or reteaching should be needed to do it)
- √ The length of the assignment must follow time frame suggested on the chart.

Grade 5 45 min

Subjects such as Estudios Sociales, Art, P.E. Social Studies, Science, Music, Technology or Pro D do not to assign HW, at all.

*Science and Social Studies may assign HW as long as it is integrated with LA.
